Product Description

Mirror Text Textile is a laminated textile and mirror glass that introduces two independent textual layers within a single architectural surface. The textile membrane is chemically perforated and screen printed with a text motif, allowing the letterforms to appear as openings within the fabric. On the front glass surface, a second text is applied in oxidized mirror. The two textual layers overlap and interact, producing shifting visual relationships as the observer moves through the space. Depending on viewing angle, light conditions, and distance, the texts can appear aligned, fragmented, or layered. The textile is dyed with dispersed pigments before lamination, introducing tonal variation and material softness that counterbalances the precision of the mirrored typography. Mirror Text Textile transforms language into a spatial experience where text, reflection, and material depth interact within the architectural environment.

Material & Construction

- Laminated textile and mirror glass
- Textile layer: chemically perforated and screen-printed textile dyed with dispersed pigments
- Mirror layer: oxidized mirror text applied to glass surface
- Residual textile fibers preserved within the laminate
- Layered textual structure embedded within laminated glass
- Double-sided visual depth through textile perforation and mirror reflection

Technical Information

- **Thickness options:** 8 / 10 / 12 / 16 mm
- **Maximum panel size:** up to 2000 × 3000 mm
- **Processing:** CNC cutting, edge polishing, custom formats
- **Safety:** laminated; tempered laminated on request
